

Good Shepherd Parish Chart for making Sacraments of Confirmation & First Eucharist

All children whether in Parish Faith Formation or Catholic School in the Diocese of Portland, are required to attend two years of Sacramental Preparation. The chart below is to help you see which class your child should be attending.

<i>Entering scenario to make Sacraments of Confirmation & First Eucharist</i>	<i>Faith Formation Class to attend</i>	<i>When will Sacraments of Confirmation & First Eucharist be celebrated?</i>
Entering 1st Grade	Sacramental Prep Year 1	Will make Sacraments next year after completing Sacramental Prep Year 2
Entering 2nd Grade after completing Sacramental Prep Year 1	Sacramental Prep Year 2	Will make their Sacraments within the coming year
Entering 2nd Grade without Sacramental Prep Year 1	Sacramental Prep Year 1	Will make Sacraments next year after completing Sacramental Prep Year 2
Entering Grade 3 after completing Sacramental Prep Year 1	Sacramental Prep Year 2	Will make their Sacraments within the coming year
Entering Grades 3-5 without Sacramental Prep Year 1	Sacramental Prep Year 1 would be the grade level they are currently attending at school Grade 3, 4/5	Will make Sacraments next year after completing Sacramental Prep Year 2, RCIA for Children
Completed Sacramental Prep Year 1 at Grade levels 3, 4/5	RCIA for Children-Sacramental Prep Year 2 for older children	Will make Sacraments within the coming year
